DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

Students in baccalaureate programs must complete a minimum of 120 hours of course work and have the proper number of credit hours as outlined in their program of study. In all baccalaureate programs, a minimum of 60 hours must be taken at the 2000 level or above; of these, a minimum of 30 hours must be taken at the 3000 and 4000 levels.

College Requirements

The College of Health and Human Services is committed to the health and well-being of our students and the public. Consequently, all College of Health and Human Services students majoring in programs that require contact with patients or clients must provide verification of appropriate immunizations and exemplify ethical practice during their academic careers at The University of Toledo. The requirements for each major are specified under the respective programs.

University Core Curriculum

Students earning bachelor's or associate's degrees in all University colleges and programs are required to complete the University Core Curriculum. Those courses are distributed in the areas of English composition, mathematics, humanities/fine arts, social sciences, natural sciences and multicultural studies (see the General Section (https://catalog.utoledo.edu/general-section/) of this catalog for details). Some colleges and programs require courses in these areas over and above those required to fulfill University core requirements. The student's academic department or college office should be contacted for specific details.

Residence Requirement

Students transferring from other institutions must earn at least 30 credit hours in the College of Health and Human Services at The University of Toledo to be eligible for graduation.

Full-time students transferring into the College of Health and Human Services must complete at least the final semester and 25 percent of their program of study in residence within the college. Part-time students must complete the last 12 credit hours and 25 percent of the program of study within the college.
